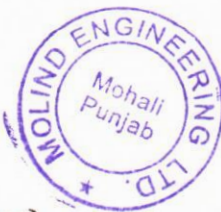

Kohli retains fourth spot

New Zealand captain Kane Williamson has reclaimed the number one position in the ICC Test Rankings for batsmen after leading his side to the World Test Championship title in Southampton last week.

The 30-year-olds knocks off 49 and 52 not out in the low-scoring final against India helped him move above the 900-point mark and he now enjoys a 10-point lead over Steve Smith (891 rating points). India skipper Virat Kohli remains in fourth position while Rohit Sharma has moved up to the sixth spot. India wicketkeeper batsman Rishabh Pant is seventh. Williamson, who conceded the top spot to Smith two weeks ago, is back in the position he had first grabbed in November 2015 during a series against Australia.

Ross Taylor, who scored an unbeaten 47 and partnered in an unbroken 96-run stand with Williamson, has advanced three places to 14th position while left-hander Devon Conway has

gained 18 slots to reach 42nd place after top-scoring with 52 in the first innings.

New Zealand's fast bowlers too have gained after thriving in the seaming conditions with player of the match Kyle Jamieson continuing the stupendous start to his Test career.

His figures of five for 31 and two for 30 have pushed him up to a career-best 13th position, not surprising since no bowler has taken more Test wickets at a better average than him since 1900.

Left-armers Trent Boult's figures of two for 48 and three for 39 have lifted him two places to 11th position while for India, vice-captain Ajinkya Rahane's progress of three places to 13th position after scores of 49 and 15, was the only notable gain.

Ravindra Jadeja has slipped behind West Indian Jason Holder to second position after a week at the top of the rankings for all-rounders.

In the T20 Rankings, West Indies' left-handed opener Evin Lewis has moved from 13th to

10th position after a player of the match effort of 71 off 35 balls in the first of the two matches of their ongoing five-match series that counted for this week's rankings. Left-arm spinner Fabian Allen has progressed 23 places to 20th position.

South Africa's Quinton de Kock (up one place to 22nd), Reeza Hendricks (up three places to 24th) and Temba Bavuma (up 24 places to 64th) are among the others to move up.

England's 3-0 series win over Sri Lanka, which should come as a morale booster for the 50-over World champions ahead of this year's ICC Men's T20 World Cup, sees several of their players move up too.

Chris Jordan (up five places to 11th), Mark Wood (up 11 places to 14th), Sam Curran (up 62 places to 39th) and David Willey (up 23 places to 51st) have progressed in the bowlers' list while for Sri Lanka, Wanindu Hasaranga has moved up five places to fifth and Dushmantha Chameera 41 places to 43rd.

AP ■ WIMBLEDON

Novak Djokovic slid, slipped, skidded and stumbled into the third round on Wimbledon's slick grass Wednesday by beating Kevin Anderson 6-3, 6-3, 6-3.

Djokovic didn't face a break point and committed just six unforced errors, including one with his forehand.

But footing continued to be an issue on the third day of the tournament, and Djokovic went sprawling several times, as did players in other matches and at least one ball kid. "I didn't slip just once; I slipped like six times," Bianca

Andreescu said after losing her first-round match.

"The courts are super slippery. I have only played here once before, but they weren't like this at all. I spoke to a couple other players, and they said it's not that normal. But this is something we can't really control."

Seven-time champion Serena Williams retired from her first-round match Tuesday with a leg injury after she slipped. Roger Federer's opponent, Adrian Panarino, had to call it quits after he fell and twisted his knee.

Persistent rain the first two days of play created slick conditions. The weather also

caused a scheduling backlog, with 27 first-round matches pushed into Wednesday.

The retractable roof was open when the top-ranked Djokovic was first on Centre Court for his rematch against Anderson, who also lost when they played in the 2018 final.

While Djokovic endured an up-and-down performance on the slippery surface and rose from one spill muttering in frustration, he had little trouble with Anderson. The preternaturally limber Djokovic extended one rally by hitting a forehand while down on his knee — and won the point.

Djokovic seeks his sixth

Wimbledon title and third in a row. By winning the championship, he would also match the record total of 20 majors shared by Roger Federer and Rafael Nadal, and would need only a title at the U.S. Open to sweep all four Grand Slams in 2021.

Andreescu made another early Grand Slam exit when she lost to Alice Cornet 6-2, 6-1. The Canadian won the 2019 Open but is 2-5 in majors since, including three opening-round defeats.

Andreescu, who has battled injuries but was seeded fifth, committed 34 unforced errors to seven for Cornet. "I tried to stay positive the whole

match," Andreescu said.

"I tried to figure it out, how I can play her better. But honestly, she played really well."

Yoshihito Nishioka overcame a 15-inch height disparity to beat 6-foot-10 John Isner 7-6 (5), 2-6, 6-3, 6-7 (7), 6-4. The match took place on Court 18, where Isner won a record fifth set 70-68 in 2010.

Also advancing was Queen's Club tournament champion Matteo Berrettini, who hit 20 aces and pulled away from Guido Pella 6-4, 3-6, 6-4, 6-0. American Sam Querrey upset No. 11 Pablo Carreño Busta 7-6 (6), 6-4, 7-5.

India Olympic preperation on track

There is great joy in winning an individual race and there is greater joy in a collective effort bearing fruit. I can say without fear of contradiction that this has been true, through the present Olympic cycle, in offering India's best athletes the opportunity to prepare themselves for Tokyo2020.

One of the most important facets of this Olympic campaign, extended by a year because of the Pandemic, is the remarkably high-level of coordination among the many parts of the Indian sports ecosystem. It has allowed a vast

majority of our Olympic hopefuls the opportunity to prepare without interruption and worry.

The coming together of key stakeholders, National Sports Federations, the Indian Olympic Association and the Sports Authority of India, on one platform has helped the campaign stay on track. It brings in an unprecedented level of transparency in clearing requests from athletes for support beyond what is secured through the Annual Calendar of Competition and Training.

As a part of the Mission Olympic Cell which oversees the Target Olympic Podium

Scheme of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, I have seen how well prepared the TOPS researchers are when it comes to performance. The diligence with which data is collated and analysed is a fair indication of the professional approach India has adopted. From helping secure ideal training locations to clearing sparring partners, from securing the services of the best possible coaches to paying for experienced and efficient support staff, from making arrangements for travel and stay to ensuring that their training and competition plan was not impacted much by the pandemic, the Indian ecosys-

tem has stood as one.

A salient feature of the way Mission Olympic Cell deals with proposals from athletes, more often than not backed by the respective National Sports Federations, is the speed at which things have been approved. As someone who has represented India at the highest level, I can tell you that such short turnaround times were unheard of until now. Of course, the uncertainty imposed on everyone by the pandemic weighed in heavily at the Mission Olympic Cell clearing most proposals without batting an eyelid. In more normal times, we would spend a bit more time scrutinising

each proposal.

The thought is to not add the stress to an athlete with any delays in the run up to the Olympics. There are lessons for everyone and the coming Olympics will only see things get better when all National Sports Federations and athletes become aware of and comply with the basic diligence that is needed in Government matters. The team spirit and the manner in which Indian sport is now drawing professional management will be of huge help in the long run.

ICC set to award same points for each match won during WTC 2

The International Cricket Council (ICC) will award standardised 12 points for every match won during the second World Test Championships cycle which kicks off with the five-match series between India and England in August.

Teams will get six points in case of a tie and four points if the match ends in a draw.

That there would be changes to the points system

was first declared by ICC interim CEO Geoff Allardice during a media interaction earlier this month. "Instead of each series being worth the same number of points, 120, irrespective of whether the series is played over two Tests or five Tests, the next cycle will see each match being worth the same number of points - a maximum of 12 per match," an ICC board member told PTI. "Teams will be ranked on the percentage of available points they won from the

matches they have played."

The changes in the points system will have to be ratified by the ICC chief executives committee in the coming weeks.

"The aim was to try and simplify the points system and to allow teams to be meaningfully compared on the table at any point, though they may have played differing numbers of matches and series," the Board member added.

Apart from the India-

England series, the Ashes later this year will be the only other five-match affair in the second cycle which will end in June 2023. Australia's tour of India next year is the only four-Test series in the upcoming cycle.

The nine Test teams will play a total of six series; three home and three away just like the previous edition.

In the inaugural edition, which New Zealand won after defeating India in the final earlier this month, the ICC

had changed the qualification criteria for the World Test Championship from maximum points earned to percentage points earned from the matches contested after many scheduled series were cancelled due to COVID-19.

During the last cycle, the value for each series was 120 points where a two-match India-Bangladesh series had 60 points for a win while a four-match India-Australia Test series had 30 points in store per victory.
